Domino's growth to bring 2,500 new Australian jobs

Domino's Pizza will create more than 2,500 employment opportunities across Australia over the next six months on the back of the robust sales it has achieved in the first four months of this Financial Year.

The new jobs will come as Domino's plans to open up to 35 – 40 new stores in the first half of this year as well as employing more team members across its 474 existing stores.

Domino's CEO Don Meij said the Company had kicked off the year with solid same store sales growth and stores are requiring more drivers and pizza makers to keep up with demand.

"Our recent performance and growth plans for the new year will see us create 2,500 new jobs across the country," Mr Meij said.

"We have experienced 10.3% Same Store Sales growth for the first four months of this year. As a result our existing stores are on the hunt for more team members to keep up with demand and prepare themselves for the upcoming holiday season, a very busy time of year for us.

"In addition, we also expect to open up to up to 25 – 30 new stores across Australia over the coming months and these will create new jobs in the local areas."

Mr Meij said Domino's was driving its store growth plans in Australia thanks to recent success it has achieved through strong promotions and a focus on technology.

"Strong promotions over the past few months as well as the use of new technology have helped us to attract new customers to our stores," Mr Meij said.

"This has given us the confidence to boost our presence across Australia by opening more stores in metro and regional areas.

"We are also progressing well with our store refurbishment program with older stores undergoing the transformation every week."

Domino's Pizza Enterprises Limited is Australia's only publicly-listed pizza company and is the master franchisor for the Domino's Pizza brand in Australia, New Zealand, France, Belgium and The Netherlands.

Domino's and its franchisees have 878 stores across five countries, employing more than 21,000 part-time and full-time staff and making more than 60 million pizzas each year.

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
